



## Hampton-in-Arden Sports Club Squash and Racketball Section

### Membership Fees 2016/2017

Our membership fees for the current year have been maintained at last years levels. Our recently refurbished courts remain free to use for members. Our aim is to encourage renewal on key day and, whilst generating sufficient funds to maintain our facilities, to make joining the section as attractive as possible. To this end we're offering generous discounts to sporting members of other sections of the club and to those who are 25 & under at 1<sup>st</sup> September. If finding the immediate finance is difficult we're offering quarterly standing orders payable direct into the Hampton Sports Club account (sort code 20-23-55, a/c no 90444871). You may also pay your key day payment direct into this account but you **must** indicate that the payment is for Squash Membership & you **must** complete & return a membership form & indicate that you have done this on the form. If you pay your renewal fee at the bar please ensure that your form is endorsed "PAID" and that your method of payment is clearly indicated.

**\*You are a sporting member if you're a paid up member of Tennis, Cricket or Hockey**

**\*\*As an off peak member you agree not to use the courts between 5pm & 9pm weekdays.**

**\*\*\* If only one of the couple is already a sporting member then £340 (£85 quarterly).**

You will be able to set up payment by quarterly standing orders for most categories. The 1<sup>st</sup> payment (1/4 of the fee due) should be paid on or before key day followed by standing order payments due 1<sup>st</sup> December, 1<sup>st</sup> March and 1<sup>st</sup> June. No key day discounts will be eligible when paying by standing order.

Pro-rata rates will be available for members joining after 1<sup>st</sup> December 2016. All memberships will expire on key day September 2017. Joining after 1st December, 3/4 of the standard rate; 1st January, 2/3 of the standard rate; 1st March, 1/2 of the standard rate; 1st May, 1/3 of the standard rate; 1st June, 1/4 of the standard rate.

New members joining after 1st August 2017 will be asked to pay the key day fee for 2017/18 and in this instance membership will run until key day September 2018.
